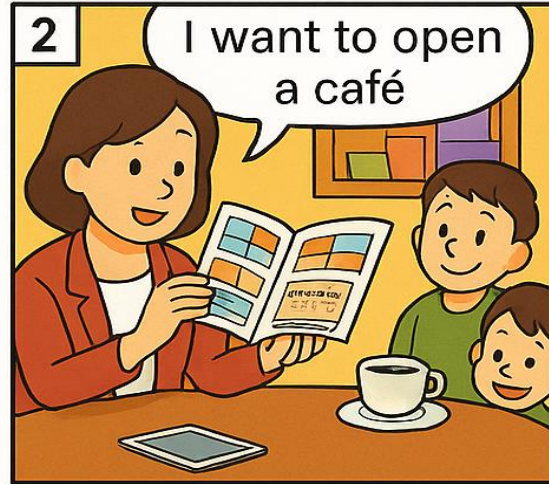
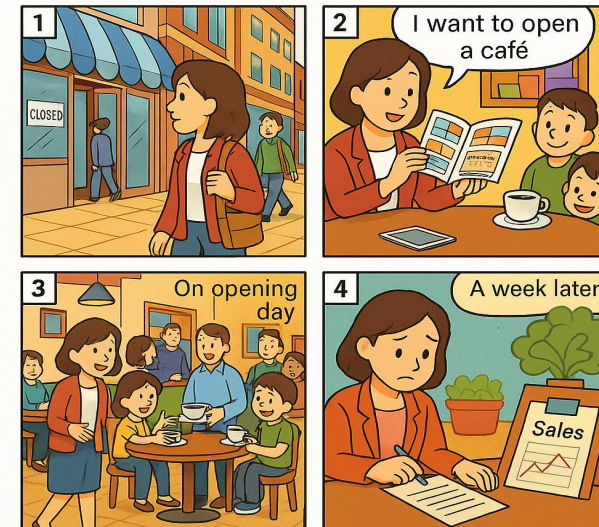


- You have one minute to prepare.

**解答例**

**Yes, I think it is difficult because people need a lot of money, time, and effort.**

**In addition, there is no guarantee of success, and they may have to deal with strong competition. For these reasons, starting a business is very challenging.**

# No. 3

## Do you think small local shops are important for communities?

**解答例**

**Yes, I think they are very important.**

**They give people chances to meet and talk with others, and they help create a warmer and friendlier atmosphere in the town.**

**Also, they provide jobs and support the local economy, so communities should try to keep them.**

**No. 4**

**Online fraud and cybercrimes often become a topic for discussion. Do you think governments should do more to solve these problems?**

**解答例**

**Yes, I think governments should do more. Many people cannot fully protect themselves, even if they are careful online. Governments can make stricter laws, punish criminals effectively, and educate citizens, which will reduce cybercrimes in society.**
